Michael Mosley Honored Posthumously at World Congress of Science & Factual Producers 2024

7 November 2024 – World Congress of Science & Factual Producers (WCSFP) is proud to announce that Michael Mosley, a celebrated journalist, executive producer, presenter, and tireless advocate for the popularization of science, has been awarded the 2024 Lifetime Achievement Award at the prestigious Buzzies Awards.

Michael passed away earlier this year of natural causes while hiking on the Greek island of Symi at the age of 67.

Known for his boundless curiosity and his unique ability to make science accessible and fun, Michael is being recognized posthumously for his outstanding contributions to science communication – particularly in the field of health – on television, radio and online as well as books and newspaper articles.

Nominated by BBC Studios, the award highlights a career and legacy that has enriched lives worldwide and continues to inspire. His wife, Clare, will accept the award on his behalf at the upcoming ceremony.
